MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This is a Memorandum of Understanding between Birmingham Municipal Adult Drug Treatment Court and Crossroads to Intervention to provide screenings, assessments, re-assessments and treatment for Birmingham Municipal Court clients with drug, alcohol and mental disorders.

Background: Recognizing the mutual need for the assessment, re-assessment and treatment of substance-abuse and mental disorders in the greater Birmingham area, the Birmingham Municipal Adult Drug Treatment Court and Crossroads to Intervention agree to the following:


Crossroads to Intervention agrees to:

- 1.) Accept Drug Court clients for screening, utilizing the GAIN-Q instrument.
- 2.) Assess clients treat clients with co-occurring disorders.
- 3.) Meet with Birmingham Municipal Adult Drug Treatment Court staff as need to collaborate and coordinate services.
- 4.) Provide alcohol and drug counseling, alternative lifestyles counseling, anger management, basic living skills training, child custody evaluation, community service, conflict resolution, criminal offender counseling, crisis intervention and resolution, diagnostic testing, domestic violence counseling.
- 5.) Provide drug and alcohol testing (same day results).
- 6.) Provide family counseling, family support, grief counseling, group counseling, individual counseling, in-home intervention, intake evaluation, jail assessments, notary, parenting skills training, sexual abuse counseling, trauma debriefing, and treatment plan review.
- 7.) Provide services and assistance to clients with children.
- 8.) Provide limited bus passes
- 9.) Use a referral network for other services.
- 10.) Provide a weekly report of compliance and non-compliance clients.


Birmingham Municipal Adult Drug Treatment Court agrees to:

- 1.) Refer clients who are in need of screening, re-assessments and treatment for substance abuse and or mental health needs.
- 2.) Provide or coordinate transportation for clients who are in need of services.
- 3.) Provide detailed reports to providers as to the progress of clients throughout the four (4) phases of the Birmingham Municipal Adult Drug Treatment Court program.
- 4.) Ensure attendance to provided classes or educational sessions by way of Court sanctions for non-compliance.
