Guidelines for Sanction Schedule:

- One sanction column is the minimum guideline for each behavior.
- All sanctions are progressive (i.e. second occurrence then sanction doubles, third occurrence sanction progress up, fourth occurrence then client jail/revoked from program.)
- Sanction maximum at any given time will be 72 hours.
- All sanctions = come back for status hearing in 2 weeks
- Missed community service = farm
- Missed farm = jail
- Missed jail = more jail or revoke
- If a status/situation has a sanction listed in more than one column, then the team can decide which sanction is the most suitable or choose more than one.
- Residential challenge will expire after 6 months of clean time. Next dirty urinalysis = return to phase I and sign a restart challenge.
- Positive drug test after Twin Rivers = Bridge/revoke
- Positive drug test after Bridge = back to Bridge/revoke
- If a client chooses to do jail instead of farm then they stay on jail sanctions
